CONTACT YOUR INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDER (ISP)

Many Internet Service Providers offered "Free and Low Cost Internet Plans" before the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP). It is expected that many will offer these Plans again when ACP benefits end. By doing so, Internet Service Providers will prevent having ACP households cancel their services. The ACP stopped accepting applications on February 7, 2024. The last fully funded month is April 2024.

Low Cost Plan Example: CHARTER SPECTRUM ASSIST PROGRAM

- TO QUALIFY - recipient of one of these assistance programs: National School Lunch Program (NSLP), Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) of the NSLP, Supplemental Security Income (for applications age 65+ only)
- THE OFFER - Internet Assist with speeds up to 30Mbps (wireless speeds may vary) for \$14.99 month for 12 months*

LIFELINE PROGRAM

Lifeline is a program backed by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). Lifeline benefits provide a discount of up to \$9.25 per month off either landline phone service, wireless phone service, broadband, or bundled services. Each household can claim only one Lifeline discount for phone OR internet service


Who Qualifies?

- Income is at or below 135% of the federal poverty guidelines
- Or Participation in:***
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefits
 - Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
 - Medicaid
 - Tribal Programs for Native Americans
